# DANDELION HAT

Hat w/dandelion pattern Instruction: Anita Brathetland

#### Sizes:

One size

#### Yarn:

KOS (62 % baby alpaca, 9 % wool, 29 % nylon, 50 g = 150 m)

## Yarn required:

Pistachio #9521: 1 ball

### Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 5 mm and 5.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

#### Tension:

16 sts x 25 rnds pattern with 5.5 mm ndls =  $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ 

## Pattern (in rnds):

Rnd 1: \*k1, insert ndl in 3rd st below 2nd st on left ndl and pull up a loop, k2, pull up a new loop in the same st, k2, pull up a new loop in the same st, k5\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd.

**Rnd 2:** \*k2tog, k1, k2tog, k1, k2tog, k5\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd.

Rnd 3 - 10: Work St-st.

Rnd 11: \*k6, insert ndl in 3rd st below 2nd st on left ndl and pull up a loop, k2, pull up a new loop in the same st, k2, pull up a new loop in the same st,\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd.

**Rnd 12:** \*k5, k2tog, k1, k2tog, k1, k2tog\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd.

Rnd 13 - 20: Work St-st.

Rep rnd 1 - 20.

With 5 mm circular ndl cast on 70 sts, Join and work 8 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 5.5 mm circular.

Work 6 rnds St-st.

Cont **pattern** until hat meas approx 21 cm, end with pattern rnd 14.

Insert marker on 8th st, then insert marker on every 10th sts in the rnd = 7 markers.

Dec at every marker as follows:

Work until 1 st before marker, sl 2 sts k-wise (as working k2tog), k1, psso = 14 sts dec.

Cont **pattern** and rep dec 3 times more on 19th, 5<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> pattern rnd = 14 sts

Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well.
