CARDIGAN IN
RIBBING*Long cardigan w/pockets*
*Instruction: Liv Stangeland***Sizes:**
(XS-S) M (L) XL**Measurements:**Bust: approx (100) 111 (123) 135 cm
+ 2½ cm at each side for front bands
Length: approx (78) 80 (82) 84 cm
Sleeve length: (47) 47 (46) 45 cm, or
suitable length

Width overarm: (32) 33 (35) 36 cm

All measurements are for the finished garment
= personal body measurements + movement
allowance. The measurements are all according
to given tension**Yarn:**SILK MOHAIR (60 % kid mohair,
15 % wool, 25 % silk, 50 g = 280 m)**Yarn required:**

Emerald #7755: (5) 5 (6) 6 balls

Suggested knitting needles:Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm
and 3 mmNeedle sizes are only suggestions. If your
knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker
needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.**Tension:**27 sts and 32 rows ribbing with 3 mm
ndls = 10 x 10 cm**Edge st: k every row****Back and front:**With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (301)
333 (365) 397 sts. Work 3,5 cm
ribbing back and forth as follows: (first
row = WS) 1 edge st, p7, p1, *k1, p1*,
rep from *-* end with p7, 1 edge st.
Insert marker at each side with (83)
91 (99) 107 sts for each front, and
(135) 151 (167) 183 sts for the back.
Change to 3 mm circular and cont in
the same order, but work firmly the 8
sts St-st for facing at each side.Cont until work meas (28) 28 (29) 30
cm. With a cotton yarn end knit
marker on sts for pockets on fronts as
follows: Work (29) 33 (36) 40 sts,
work 29 sts with cotton yarn, transfer
sts back to left ndl and with workingyarn knit the 29 sts as before, cont
until (58) 62 (65) 69 sts rem. Work 29
sts with cotton yarn, transfer sts back
to left ndl and with working yarn knit
the 29 sts as before, cont to end of
row. Cont until garment meas (46) 47
(48) 49 cm.

Dec for v-neck as follows:

Work 1 edge st, 7 sts St-st, p2/k2tog
tbl, cont until 10 sts rem, end with
p2/k2tog, 7 sts St-st, 1 edge st.Rep v-neck dec every 4th row a total
of 4 times.Cont until work meas approx (52) 53
(54) 55 cm. Cast off 5 sts at each
side for armholes = 2 sts on front and
3 sts on back. Put garment aside and
work sleeves.**Sleeves:**With 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast
on (58) 60 (62) 64 sts. Join and work
4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.Insert marker at beg of rnd. Change to
3 mm double pointed and cont ribbing
in rnds.Inc 2 sts at center underarm as
follows: Pick up yarn between 2 sts
and work k1, k1 tbl. Rep inc every (3)
2,5 (2,5) 2 cm until (86) 90 (94) 98
sts.Cont until sleeve meas (47) 47 (46)
45 cm, or suitable length.Cast off 5 center underarm sts, k1,
p1, k1, p1, k1.Put aside and work other sleeve the
same.**Raglan:**Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3
mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve
above each armhole cast-off = (445)
485 (525) 565 sts. Insert marker on 5
sts at each junction (= 2 sts on
garment, 3 sts on sleeve) and work
these sts rib-wise further on.Read following chapter before
continue knitting:Cont v-neck dec every 4th row as
before, **at the same time** dec for
raglan at each marker as follows:Work until 3 sts rem before marker, sl
1 k-wise, k2tog, pssso, work marked
sts, k3tog = 18 sts decRep dec for raglan and v-neck every
4th row (14) 16 (18) 20 times = (193)
197 (201) 205 sts on row.Cont dec for v-neck every 4th row as
before, and dec for raglan on alt rows
over sts for back and front, (not over
sleeve sts) until 11 sts rem at each
side and v-neck dec meets raglan
dec. Transfer 8 sts at each side tospare ndl (= facing). Work 1 row and
cast off rem sts.Cast on 1 st (= edge st) and transfer 8
facing sts to 3 mm ndl. Work St-st
back and forth inside 1 edge st at
each side until band reaches center
back neck when slightly stretched.Work other side in the same manner.
Graft bands tog at center back and
sew band at neck edge.**Finishing:**Fold 8 facing sts to WS and sew with
hidden sts.

Sew underarm openings.

Pockets:Remove cotton yarn for pocket
marking, transfer 29 sts at each side
to 3 mm double pointed ndls and pick
up 1 new st at each side = 60 sts.Work 14 cm St-st in rnds. Cast off.
Sew pouch tog at bottom.

Work other pocket the same.

With double yarn sew pouch lightly to
front as followsFasten yarn at a corner of pouch, with
one stitch fasten yarn to garment with
approx 1 cm allowance of yarn, twirl
ndl around the 1 cm yarn between
pouch and garment and fasten well at
corner of pouch. Fasten other corner
in the same manner.

Work other pocket the same.
