# COTTON WOOL CARDIGAN

Cardigan w/rib-patter on round yoke Instruction: Liv Stangeland

Sizes:

(XS) S (M) L (XL)

#### Measurements:

Bust: (97) 105 (111) 117 (127) cm Length: (76) 77 (79) 80 (80) cm Width overarm: (30) 32 (34) 35 (37)

Sleeve length: 46 cm, or suitable length.

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

#### Yarn:

TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair, 28 % silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m) SISU (80 % wool, 20 % nylon, 50 g = 175 m)

## Yarn required:

TYNN SILK MOHAIR Ochre #2136: (5) 6 (6) 6 (7) balls SISU

Yellow sand #2134: (7) 7 (8) 9 (10) balls

#### **Notions:**

(9) 9 (9) 10 (10) buttons

## Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed ndls 4 mm and 5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

## Tension:

19 sts St-st with double yarn (1 strand TYNN SILK MOHAIR + 1 strand SISU) and 5 mm ndls = 10 cm
19 sts and 30 rows pattern with

19 sts and 30 rows pattern with double yarn and 4 mm ndls = 10x10 cm

## Rib stitch (rib-st):

K1 in st on previous row

## Pattern:

**Row 1:** (= WS) 1 edge st, k7 \*p1, k7\*, rep from \*-\* end with 1 edge st. **Row 2:** (= RS) 1 edge st, p7, \*1 rib-st,

p7\*, rep from \*-\* end with 1 edge st.

Rep pattern row 1 and 2 with 1 p st less at each p-section according to instruction

## Edge st: k every row

## **Back and front**

With double yarn and 5 mm circular ndl cast on (183) 197 (209) 221 (239) sts. Work 4 cm ribbing back and forth as follows: (1st row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, \*k1, p1\*, rep from \*-\* end with 1 edge st.

Insert marker at sides with (45) 49 (52) 55 (60) sts for each front and (93) 99 (105) 111 (119) sts for the back. Cont St-st until garment meas (54) 55 (55) 56 (54) cm.

Cast off (10) 11 (10) 10 (11) sts at each side for armholes (= (5) 6 (5) 5 (6) sts at back and 5 sts at front). Put aside and work sleeves.

#### Sleeves:

With double yarn and 4 mm double pointed ndls cast on (38) 38 (40) 40 (42) sts. Join and work 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Change to 5 mm double pointed ndls, k 1 rnd, **while** inc (19) 22 (24) 26 (29) sts evenly spaced = (57) 60 (64) 66 (71) sts. Cont St-st until sleeve meas 46 cm, or suitable length. Cast off (10) 11 (10) 10 (11) middle underarm sts.

Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

## Dec for raglan and work extra height at back:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 5 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (257) 273 (297) 313 (337) sts. Insert marker at each of the 4 junctions.

Work extra height at back using "German short rows" as follows:

Work until 9 sts rem, turn, sl first st with yarn in front of work, lead yarn over right ndl and pull firmly at the back until 2 loops on right ndl. P back until 9 sts rem at other side, turn, sl first st with yarn in front of work, lead yarn over right ndl and pull firmly at the back until 2 loops on right ndl.

Cont St-st back and forth and with 9 sts less for each turning, until a total of 3 times at each side, at the same time dec for raglan on every RS-row at each marker as follows:

Work until 2 sts before marker, sl 1 k-wise, k1, psso, k2tog = 8 sts dec. K 1 row over all sts, **at the same time** k loops tog.

#### Round yoke:

= (233) 249 (273) 289 (313) sts.

Change to 4 mm circular ndl.

Work (3) 3 (4) 4 (4½) cm **pattern** inside 1 edge st at each side.

From RS of pattern dec as follows: \*p3, p2tog, p2, 1 rib-st\*, rep from \*-\* in the row = (204) 218 (239) 253 (274) sts. (= (29) 31 (34) 36 (39) sts are dec every dec-row.)

Work (4) 4 (4) 4 (4) cm pattern, but with p6 at each p-section.

Dec in pattern as follows: \*p2, p2tog, p2, 1 rib-st\*, rep from \*-\* in the row = (175) 187 (205) 217 (235) sts.

Work  $(3\frac{1}{2})$   $3\frac{1}{2}$   $(3\frac{1}{2})$   $3\frac{1}{2}$  (4) cm pattern, but with p5 at each p-section. Dec in pattern as follows: \*p1, p2tog, p2, 1 rib-st\*, rep from \*-\* in the row = (146) 156 (171) 181 (196) sts.

Work (3) 3 (3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  (4) cm pattern, but with p4 at each p-section.

Dec in pattern as follows: \*p1, p2tog, p1, 1 rib-st\*, rep from \*-\* in the row = (117) 125 (137) 145 (157) 157 sts.

Work (3) 3 (3½) 3½ (4) cm pattern, but with p3 at each p-section.

Dec in pattern as follows: \*p1, p2tog, 1 rib-st\*, rep from \*-\* in the row = (88) 94 (103) 109 (118) sts.

Pattern section meas approx (16½) 16½ (18½) 18½ (20½) cm.

Work 4 rows all sizes.

Change to 5 mm ndl and work 2 cm ribbing as follows: 1 edge st, \*k1, p1\*, rep from \*-\*, end with 1 edge st. Cast off suitably firm.

## Finishing:

## Left front band:

With double yarn and 5 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row on left front edge to approx (149) 151 (155) 157 sts. Number of sts a multiple of 2 + 1. Work 2 cm ribbing as back and front (first row = WS). Cast off rib-wise.

#### Right front band:

Work in the same manner as left band but with (9) 9 (9) 10 (10) buttonholes evenly spaced on second row. The upper and lower 5 sts inside each edge.

#### Buttonhole:

Cast off 1 st. Next row: cast on 1 st above the cast-off.

Sew underarm openings. Sew buttons on.





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
