SILJA SWEATER

Sweater w/raglan worked from neck down

Instruction: Liv Inger Espedal

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (65) 65 (76) 76 (87) 87 cm

Length: (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm, or suitable length

Sleeve length: (24) 26 (31) 34 (38) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

Yarn:

MERINOULL (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 105 m)

Alternative yarn:

PEER GYNT, SMART, ALPAKKA, DUO, MANDARIN MEDI, SPØT

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Lt.heather #4622: (5) 6 (8) 9 (11) 12 balls

Notions:

1 small button

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3mm and 3.5 mm

Crochet hook 2.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

Tension:

22 sts pattern with 3.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

Begin at neck.

Work back and forth at beginning for slit at center back.

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (73) 73 (97) 97 (97) 97 sts, and work 3 rows ribbing back and forth as follows: (first row = WS) p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-* in the row.

Change to 3.5 mm circular and work ribbing as follows:

k1, *p5, k1*, rep from *-* in the row.

Insert marker on 4 k sts on the row as follows = sts for raglan inc:

Insert marker on the (13th) 13th (19th) 19th (19th) 19th and (25th) 25th (31st) 31st (31st) 31st sts from each side of work = (12) 12 (18) 18 (18) 18 sts for each side of the back, 11 sts for sleeves and (23) 23 (35) 35 (35) 35 sts for front

Cont in this order and work extra height at back with «german short rows» to avoid holes in garment in this manner:

Work (26) 26 (32) 32 (32) 32 sts, turn, sl first st to right ndl with yarn in front of work, tighten yarn firmly at the back until 2 loops on right ndl, work to end of row.

Work (28) 28 (34) 34 (34) 34 sts, work loops tog, turn, sl first st to right ndl with yarn in front of work, tighten yarn firmly at the back until 2 loops on right

ndl, work to end of row.

Work 1 row over all sts, and work accordingly at other side.

On RS inc for raglan as follows: 1 yo at each side of marked sts = 8 sts inc. On WS work k on k sts, p on p sts and k all yo.

Cont diagram back and forth and beg at arrow for chosen size as follows: 12 rows **diagram**, end with k1 at slit edge as beg of row, work and inc as shown in diagram until 7 times of raglan inc are finished

= (129) 129 (153) 153 (153) 153 sts.

After 7 raglan inc k tog first and last st on row and cont in rounds.

Rep raglan inc as shown (13) 14 (15) 16 (17) 18 times more, and on last rnd cast off the 4 marked sts = (228) 236 (268) 276 (284) 292 sts on rnd.

Arrange sts on ndl as follows:

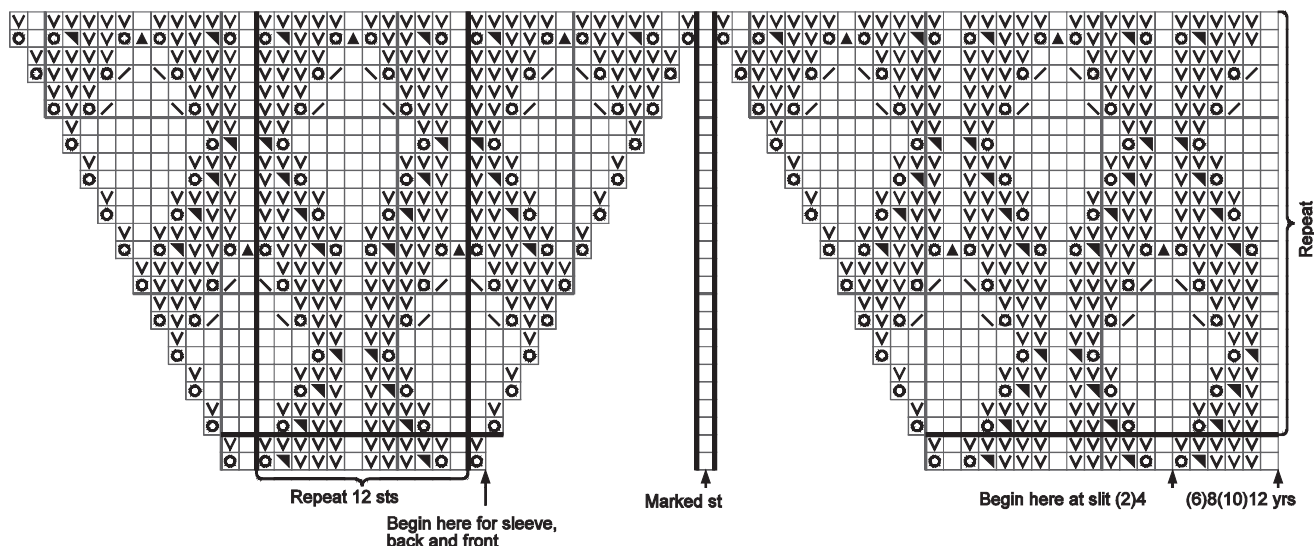
(63) 65 (79) 81 (83) 85 sts for back and front and (51) 53 (55) 57 (59) 61 sts for sleeves. These are worked separately later.

Back and front:

With 3.5 mm circular ndl cast on (5) 4 (3) 2 (7) 6 new underarm sts, work sts for front, cast on (9) 7 (5) 3 (13) 11 new underarm sts at other side, work sts for the back and cast on (4) 3 (2) 1 (6) 5 new underarm sts = (144) 144 (168) 168 (192) 192 sts on rnd.

Insert marker on first st = beg of rnd.

Cont **diagram** in rnds until garment meas (34) 38 (42) 46 (48) 50 cm from shoulder, or 2 cm before suitable length.

Change to 3 mm circular.

Work 2 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds

Cast off rib-wise.

Sleeves:

Transfer sleeve sts to 3.5 mm double pointed ndls, and pick up 1 st in each underarm st at back and front = (60) 60 (60) 60 (72) 72 sts.

Rnd beg at center underarm.

Cont **diagram** in rnds until sleeve meas (22) 24 (29) 32 (36) 38 cm meas at underarm, or 2 cm before suitable length

Change to 3 mm double pointed, k 1 rnd, **while** dec evenly spaced to (36) 38 (40) 42 (44) 46 sts.

Work 2 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Work other sleeve the same.

Finishing:

With crochet hook work 1 row sc at each side of slit, and ch5 for buttonloop at one side at neck.

Sew button on.
