SIZE

One size

THE FLOWER

Work flower from center outwards.

Beg to work around a magic circle, cont to work 3 petals, but only through front part of stitch, cont to work sc through back part of stitch. At end work 4 petals through both parts of stitch.

Feel free to try out different kind of yarns and sizes of crochet hooks for exciting new images of the rose.

YARN

MANDARIN PETIT (100 % cotton, 50 g = 180 m)

YARN REQUIRED

Shocking pink #4626/Sunny Lime 9825: 1 ball

SUGGESTED CROCHET HOOK

4 mm

Size of hook is just suggestion. If your crocheting shows tighter tension, use thicker hook, for looser tension use thinner hook.

MAGIC CIRCLE

Twirl yarn once around index finger and middle finger to form a loop. With crochet hook pick up yarn through loop to work 1 sc.

ROSE

Rnd 1: With double yarn and 4 mm hook work 12 sc in a magic circle, join with 1 sl.

Rnd 2: Work through front part of stitch only in this manner: Work ch3, 1 dc in first sc, work 2 dc in each of the next 3 sc, *work (1 dc, ch3, fasten with 1 sl in same sc, cont in same sc and ch3, 1 dc), work 2 dc in each of the next 3 sc*, rep from *-* once more, end with 1 dc, ch3, fasten with 1 sl in first sc = 3 petals with 10 dc for each petal.

Rnd 3: Cont in back part of stitch on same rnd and work 2 sc in each sc, join with 1 sl in first sc = 24 sc.

Rnd 4: Work through both parts of stitch in this manner: Work ch3, 1 tr in first sc, work 2 tr in each of the next 5 sc, *work (1 tr, ch3, fasten with 1 sl in same

sc, cont in same sc and ch3, 1 tr), work 2 tr in each of the next 5 sc*, rep from *-* twice more, end with 1 tr, ch3, fasten with 1 sl in first sc = 4 petals with 14 tr for each petal.

Cut yarn and fasten well.

CORD

With double yarn and 4 mm hook ch100.

For your own choice, work more or fewer ch according to length of cord.

FINISHING

Pass cord through first rnd of sc.

Do not fasten cord to rose but leave options where to tie cord for placement of the rose.
