# **AUGUST DRESS**

Dress w/rib-pattern and round yoke Instruction: Olaug Beate Bjelland

#### Sizes:

(1) 2 (3) 4 (6) 8 yrs

#### Measurements:

Chest width: (52) 55 (58) 61 (64) 67

Hem width: (78) 82 (87) 91 (96) 100

Length: approx (40) 44 (48) 50 (54) 60 cm

Sleeve length: (21) 24 (26) 28 (30) 34 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

#### Yarn:

BABYULL LANETT (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

# Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, **TYNN** MERINOULL, **ALPAKKA** SILKE, TYNN ALPAKKA ULL, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

#### Yarn required:

Putty #1015: (5) 6 (6) 7 (8) 9 balls

# Notions:

1 small button

#### Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3 mm Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

#### Tension:

27 sts and 44 rnds pattern with 3 mm ndls = approx 10x10 cm

1 ridge: = k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd

## Rib-stitch (rib-st)

K1 in st on previous rnd

#### Rib-pattern:

Rnd 1: \*p1, k1\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd.

Rnd 2: \*p1, 1 rib-st \*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd.

Work a total of 10 rnds rib-pattern:

Rnd 11: work p. Rnd 12: work k.

Rep rnd 1 - 12 = 1 pattern repeat which meas 2 cm.

#### **Back and front:**

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (210) 222 (234) 246 (258) 270 sts. Join and work 3 rnds ridges.

Conr rib-pattern in rnds until garment meas (28) 31 (31) 34 (36) 42 cm, end with 12th rnd of rib-pattern, at the same time dec as follows:

Work \*k1, k2tog\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd = (140) 148 (156) 164 (172) 180

Insert marker around 1 st at each side with (69) 73 (77) 81 (85) 89 sts between markers.

Cont rib-pattern until garament meas approx (29) 33 (34) 36 (38) 44 cm, and p marked sts.

Cast off (9) 9 (9) 13 (13) 13 sts at each side for armholes (= marked st + (4) 4 (4) 6 (6) 6 sts at each side). Put garment aside and work sleeves.

# Sleeves:

With 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (34) 36 (38) 40 (42) 42 sts. Join and work ridges in rnds, while inc evenly spaced (48) 54 (56) 62 (64) 68 sts on last rnd.

Insert marker around first st of rnd. Cont rib-pattern until sleeve meas (21) 24 (26) 28 (30) 34 cm, or suitable length, p marked st further and end with the same pattern rnd as back/front.

Cast off (9) 9 (9) 13 (13) 13 middle underarm sts.

Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

### Yoke:

Rnd beg at a junction on the back.

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (200)220 (232) 236 (248) 264 sts.

Cont in the same order as before, at the same time dec on 12th pattern rnd (16) 28 (32) 36 (40) 48 sts evenly spaced = (184) 192 (200) 200 (208)216 sts.

Work (1) 1 (2) 2 (2) 2 pattern repeats, at the same time dec on 12th rnd of last pattern repeat in this manner: \*k6, k2tog\*, rep from \*-\*, end

with k(8) 0 (8) 8 (0) 8 = (162) 168 (176) 176 (182) 190 sts.

Work (1) 1 (1) 1 (2) 2 pattern repeats, at the same time dec on 12th rnd of last pattern repeat in this manner: \*k2, k2tog, k1, k2tog\*, rep from  $^*-^*$ , end with k(1) 0 (1) 1 (0) 1 = (116) 120 (126) 126 (130) 136 sts.

Work 1 pattern repeat, at the same time dec on 12th rnd of pattern repeat in this manner: \*k2tog k3\*, rep from \*-\*, end with (2 k2tog) 0 (k2tog) k2tog (0) k2tog = (92) 96 (100) 100 (104)108 sts.

Cut yarn and beg again at middle back. Work neckband back and forth, first row = WS.

K 5 rows (= 3 ridges), while dec on first row as follows: \*k2, k2tog\*, rep from \*-\* to end of row = (69) 72 (75)75 (78) 81 sts, and work buttonhole on 2<sup>nd</sup> row as follows: k1, 1 yo and k2tog.

Cast off.

## Finishing:

Sew underarm opening. Sew button on.
