LIVIA COLLAR

II

Round collar with beads
Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Size:
 One Size

Yarn:
 TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair,
 28 % silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m)

Yarn required:
 Lt.grey melange #1022: 1 ball

Notions:
 Black beads # Ø 3,8 – 4,5 mm
 Elastic band in suitable length for
 neck

Suggested knitting needles:
 Circular ndl 3 mm
 Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your
 knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker
 needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:
 24 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

First ridge:
 p 1 rnd, k 1 rn

INFO: Work collar from neck down,
 and with neck band without beads.
 Place beads randomly at your own
 choice on collar

Beg threading beads on yarn.
 With 3 mm circular ndl cast on 132
 sts. Join and work 3 cm St-st in rnds.
 All further measurements from this
 rnd
 Next rnd: inc as follows:
 Work *[k1, k1 tbl, k1] in next st, [k1, k1
 tbl]) in each of the next 2 sts*, rep
 from *-* in the rnd = 308 sts.
 Work 1 rnd St-st.
 Next rnd: Place 80 beads randomly as
 follows:
 Work until st for placing a bead, pull
 up one bead to top of yarn, sl 1 st with
 yarn in front of work. Bead will now be
 in front of the sl st.
 Work 1 rnd St-st.
 Cont to place beads on alt rnds until
 collar meas approx 14 cm, end with 1
 rnd St-st.
 Work 3 ridges in rnds.

Cast off suitably loose.

Finishing:
 Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely
 with hidden sts.
 Pass elastic band through neckband
 and adjust to suitable neck width.
