SOCKS

Socks in St-st worked from toe up Instruction: Olaug Beate Bjelland

Shoe sizes (EU):

(28-31) 32-35 (36-38) 40-42 (44-46)

Yarn:

PERFECT (80% wool, 20% nylon, 50 g = 100 m)

Alternative yarn:

KlompeLOMPE SPØT

Yarn required:

Pale wine print #4354/ Grey print #2100/ Blue-grey print #6562: (1) 2 (2) 3 (3) balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Double pointed 3.5 mm, or circular using magic loop

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

22 sts St-st with 3.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

Inc for toe in this manner:

*Work 1 st, inc left as follows:

Pick up yarn before next st, transfer new st k-wise to left ndl, and k tbl this new st.

Work until 1 st rem before marker at the other side, <u>inc right</u> as follows: Pick up yarn before next st, transfer

new st k tbl to left ndl, and k this new st, work 1 st*, rep from *-*.

Beg at toe:

With 3.5 mm ndls cast on (12) 12 (16) 16 (20) sts. Join and k 1 rnd.

Insert marker at each side with (6) 6 (8) 8 (10) sts for each part.

Cont St-st in rnds and inc for toe as explained = 4 sts inc.

Rep inc on alt rnds until (36) 40 (44) 48 (52) sts.

Cont St-st until work meas approx (13-14) 15-16 (17-18) 19-20 (21-22)

Work the (18) 20 (22) 24 (26) sts for sole to a marking thread (in a contrast color) for heel, transfer sts back to left ndls and work 2 cm St-st in rnds over all sts.

Work (10) 11 (12) 14 (16) cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Heel:

Pick up 1 st in every st at each side of marking thread = (36) 40 (44) 48 (52) sts.

Insert marker at each side with (18) 20 (22) 24 (26) sts for each part. Pull out marking thread, and k 1 rnd. *Dec on next rnd as follows: work 1 st, k2tog, work until 3 sts before marker, sl 1 k-wise, transfer st k tbl back to left ndl, and k2tog tbl, end with k1*, rep

Rep dec on alt rnds until 8 sts rem. Cut yarn, pull through sts.

Sew tog at toe.

Fasten all yarn ends well on WS. Work other sock in the same manner.
