## PIA SWEATER

Sweater w/side slits  
Instruction: Liv Stangeland

**Sizes:**  
(XS) S (M) L (XL- XXL)

**Measurements:**

Bust: (101) 105 (110) 114 (120) cm  
Length back: (60) 60 (61) 62 (63) cm  
Sleeve length: (45) 45 (45) 44 (43) cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

**Yarn:**

SUNDAY (100% merino wool,  
50 g = 235 m)  
TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair,  
28 % silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m)

**Yarn required:**

SUNDAY  
Dusty olive green #9071: (4) 5 (250) 6 (6) balls  
TYNN SILK MOHAIR  
Dusty olive green #9071: (4) 6 (6) 6 (7) balls

**Suggested knitting needles:**

Circular and double pointed 4 mm  
Small 3.5 mm circular for neckband  
Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

**Tension:**

21 sts x 28 rows St-st with double yarn and 4 mm ndls = 10 x 10 cm

**Edge st: k every row****NOTE:**

Change to new ball of yarn at side of garment and at underarm.

**Work garment with double yarn, 1 strand SUNDAY + 1 strand TYNN SILK MOHAIR****Inc 1 st in this manner:**

After marker: Inc 1 by picking up yarn after marker and work this new st k tbl/p tbl according to sts for ribbing.

Before marker: Inc 1 by picking up yarn before marker and work this new st k1 tbl/p1 tbl according to sts for ribbing.

**Back:**

With double yarn and 4 mm circular ndl cast on (118) 122 (130) 134 (138) sts.

Work back and forth 9 cm ribbing and with St-sts at each side in this manner: (First row = WS) 1 edge st, p9, k2, \*p2, k2\*, rep from \*-\* end with p9, 1 edge st.

K 1 row, **while** dec (2) 2 (4) 4 (2) sts evenly spaced (= (116) 120 (126) 130 (136) sts.

Cont St-st until back meas 18 cm, **at the same time** cast off 5 sts (= facing for slit) at each side = (106) 110 (116) 120 (126) sts.

Put back aside and work front.

**Front:**

With double yarn and 4 mm circular ndl cast on (102) 106 (114) 118 (122) sts.

Work 5 rows in the same manner as the back.

Insert marker 10 sts from edge at each side and cont in this manner:

1 edge st, k9, inc 1 st k-wise, work until next marker at other side, inc 1 st k-wise, k9, 1 edge st.

Rep inc in ribbing on alt rows 8 times at each side = (118) 122 (130) 134 (138) sts. Cont until ribbing meas 9 cm.

Work 1 row St-st over all sts, **at the same time** cast off 5 sts at each side (= sts for facing) and dec (2) 2 (4) 4 (2) sts evenly spaced on row = (106) 110 (116) 120 (126) sts.

**Back and front:**

Transfer sts for both parts to the same 4 mm circular ndl = (212) 220 (232) 240 (252) sts.

Insert marker at each side.

Cont St-st in rnds until back meas 39 cm.

Cast off 8 sts at each side for armholes (= 4 sts at each side of markers).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

**Sleeves:**

With double yarn and 4 mm double pointed ndls cast on (52) 52 (56) 56 (56) sts. Join and work 8 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds. Insert marker around first and last st on rnd. Cont St-st and inc 1 st at each side of marker.

Rep inc approx every (3) 3 (3) 2½ (2) cm a total of (12) 12 (12) 14 (16) times = (76) 76 (80) 84 (88) sts. Cont

until sleeve meas (45) 45 (45) 44 (43) cm, or suitable length.

Cast off 8 middle underarm sts (= marked sts + 3 sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

**Raglan:**

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 4 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (332) 340 (360) 376 (396) sts.

Insert one marker around 8 sts at each junction on back and front sts (= 8 sts for diagram) and one marker 4 sts in on each side of sleeve sts = 8 markers on rnd.

Rnd beg at right side on the back. Work 2 rnds as follows: \*Diagram A, work until marker at other side, diagram B, work sleeve sts\*, rep from \*-\*.

Work diagram A and B further and dec for raglan as follows: \*Work Diagram A, k3tog, work until 3 sts before marker, sl 1 k-wise, k2tog, pss0, diagram B, k4, k3tog, work until 3 sts before next marker, sl 1 k-wise, k2tog, pss0, k4\*, rep from \*-\* = 16 sts dec.

Rep dec every 6th rnd a total of 4 times = (268) 276 (296) 312 (332) sts. Cont dec every 4th rnd (4) 4 (5) 6 (7) times = (204) 212 (216) 216 (220) sts.

Cont dec on alt rnds 4 times over sts for back/front, **at the same time** dec 2 times every 4<sup>th</sup> rnd over sleeve sts. Work to end of rnd and (156) 164 (168) 168 (172) sts rem.

Transfer the (18) 20 (20) 20 (22) middle front sts to spare ndl for neck.

Beg row at neck.

Work cable twists on RS rows.

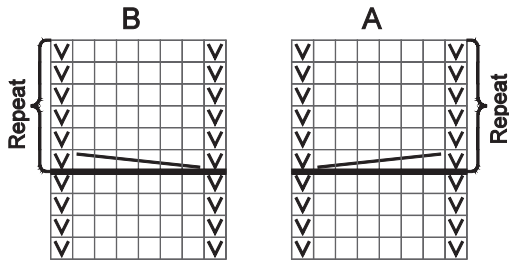
Cont back and forth and cont dec on alt rows 4 times over sts for back/front and every 4th row 2 times more over sleeve sts when possible, **at the same time** cast off 2 sts at beg of every row at each side for neck. Cast off.

**Neckband:**

With double yarn and small 3.5 mm circular ndl knit sts from spare ndl and knit up sts at neck edge, 1 st in every st, but miss every 4<sup>th</sup> st. P 1 rnd and **at the same time** adjust number of sts to (108) 108 (112) 116 (116). Work 2½ cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds. Cast off rib-wise.

**Finishing:**

Slit: Fold the 5 sts at each side to WS  
and sew with hidden sts.  
Sew underarm openings.



- k on RS, p on WS
- p on RS, k on WS
- transfer 3 sts to extra ndl and hold in back of work, k3, k sts from extra ndl
- transfer 3 sts to extra ndl and hold in front of work, k3, k sts from extra ndl
