SIZE

One size

GARN

SMART (100 % wool, Superwash,
50 g = 100 m)
TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair, 28 %
silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m)

YARN REQUIRED

SMART
Terracotta #3544: 2 balls
TYNN SILK MOHAIR
Rust #3554: 1 ball

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Double pointed 3.5 mm and 4 mm
Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your
knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker
needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

18 sts St-st with double yarn (= 1 strand
SMART + 1 strand TYNN SILK MOHAIR)
and 4 mm ndls = 10 cm
28 sts diagram = 10 cm

With double yarn and 3.5 mm double
pointed ndls cast on 96 sts. Join and work 14
cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds.


Turn work with WS facing (for best look
when ribbing is folded). Change to 4 mm
double pointed ndls, work diagram **A**, and
inc as shown = 144 sts.

Rep diagram **A** until work meas approx 24
cm from cast on row, end with a full diagram.
Cont with diagram **B** and dec as shown in
diagram = 24 sts.

Work 1 rnd over sts as they appear.

Cut yarn, pass through rem sts, gather and
fasten well on WS.



SIZES

One size

YARN

SMART (100 % wool, Superwash, 50 g = 100 m)
TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair, 28 % silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m)

YARN REQUIRED

SMART
Terracotta #3544: 100 gram
TYNN SILK MOHAIR
Rust #3554: 25 gram

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Double pointed 3.5 mm and 4 mm
Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

18 sts St-st with double yarn (= 1 strand SMART + 1 strand TYNN SILK MOHAIR) and 4 mm ndls = 10 cm
14 sts diagram = 5 cm

INC 1 ST

Pick up yarn from previous rnd before next st and k this new st tbl.

RIGHT MITTEN

With double yarn and 3.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on 36 sts. Join and work 9 cm ribbing p2, k2. Insert marker at each side with 18 sts for each part.

Change to 4 mm double pointed ndls. Work 2 rnds diagram and St-st as follows: k4, work diagram A, and work St-st to end of rnd. P sts in diagram matches p sts in ribbing. After inc of diagram there are 22 sts for top of hand.

Arrange sts on 3 double pointed ndls as follows:

First ndl: 22 sts = for top of hand.

Second ndl: 9 sts.

Third ndl: 9 sts.

Second and 3rd ndl = for palm of hand.

Cont in this order, at the same time inc for thumb gusset on second ndl as follows:

Work 2 sts, inc 1 st and cont to end of rnd.

Work 1 rnd without inc.

Work 2 sts on second ndl, inc 1 st, k1, inc 1 st = 3 sts for gusset, cont to end of rnd.

Rep inc on alt rnds with 2 sts more for gusset after each rnd of inc until 11 sts for gusset.

Transfer these 11 sts for thumb to a separate yarn end and cast on 2 new sts at back of thumb = 22 sts for top of hand and 20 sts for

palm of hand.

Cont St-st and diagram A until work meas approx 15-16 cm, from after ribbing, or 3 cm before suitable length, and end with a full diagram.

Work diagram B, and dec for top of hand as shown in diagram and at the same time dec 1 st at beg of second ndl (= sl 1 k-wise, transfer st back to left ndl and k2tog tbl), cont until 2 sts rem on third ndl, k2tog = 4 sts dec.

Work dec on every rnd.

When diagram is finished, 26 sts rem.

Cont to work sts as they appear and dec on top of hand in the same manner as palm of hand until 10 sts rem.

Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well on WS.

THUMB

Transfer sts for thumb to 4 mm double pointed ndls, knit up 2 new sts at side, 1 st in each of the 2 new sts at back and 1 st at the other side = 16 sts.

Work 6 cm St-st in rnds.

K2tog in the rnd = 8 sts.

K 1 rnd, then k2tog in the rnd.

Cut yarn, pass through the 4 rem sts, gather and fasten well on WS.

LEFT MITTEN

Work in the same manner as right mitten, but in a mirror image. Beg with k2, p2.

Arrange sts as follows:

First ndl: k9.

Second ndl: k9


First and second ndl = palm of hand.

Third ndl: k4, diagram A, k4 = top of hand.

The p sts in diagram matches p sts in ribbing.

Inc for gusset when 2 sts rem on second ndl.
