SIZES

(XS) S (M) L (XL) XXL

MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (85) 95 (101) 112 (117) 128 cm with approx 5 cm wrap over
Length: approx (50) 52 (54) 56 (56) 57 cm
Sleeve length: 47 cm, or suitable length
All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

YARN

PEER GYNT (100 % Norwegian wool, 50 g = 91 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN

ALPAKKA, SMART, MERINOULL, DUO
Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

YARN REQUIRED

Dk-blue #6572: (8) 9 (9) 10 (11) 12 balls
Burnt tawny #2544: (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) 3 balls
White #1002: (3) 3 (3) 3 (4) 4 balls
Grey-beige melange #2650: (1) 1 (1) 1 (2) 2 balls

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 3 mm and 3.5 mm
Crochet hook 3 mm
Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

TENSION

22 sts St-st with 3.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

BACK AND FRONT

With burnt tawny and 3.5 mm circular ndl cast on (193) 217 (229) 253 (265) 289 sts.
Work St-st with stripe pattern back and forth for facing in this manner:
Work 2 rows burnt tawny, *2 rows grey-beige melange, 2 rows burnt tawny*, rep from *-* a total of 4 times.
From WS k 1 row with burnt tawny for folding row.

All further measurements from this row.

Change to dk.blue, cont St-st and cast on 5 new sts at end of row for cutting sts. These sts are not included in pattern or given number of sts.

Join and cont in rnds. Insert marker at sides with (49) 56 (59) 65 (68) 74 sts for each front and (95) 105 (111) 123 (129) 141 sts for the back.

Work diagram.

Change to dk.blue and cont St-st until garment meas (31) 32 (33) 34 (34) 34 cm.
Cast off 8 sts at each side for armholes (= 4 sts at each side of markers) and work each side separately.

EDGE ST: K EVERY ROW

BACK

= (87) 97 (103) 115 (121) 133 sts.
Cont St-st back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side, at the same time cast off for armholes at beg of every row at each side 3 sts (0)0(0)1(1)1 time, 2 sts (0)2(3)3(3)4 times, 1 st (4)4(4)5(5)6 times and (79) 81 (83) 87 (93) 99 sts rem.

Cont until back meas (46) 48 (50) 52 (52) 53 cm from folding row.

Cast off the 31 middle sts for neck and work each side separately.

Cast off at beg of every row from neck side 2 sts once, 1 st 3 times = (19) 20 (21) 23 (26) 29 sts rem.

Cont until back meas (50) 52 (54) 56 (56) 57 cm and transfer sts to spare ndl.

Work other side the same but in a mirror image.

FRONT

= (90) 104 (110) 122 (128) 140 sts.

Beg at one side.

Work St-st back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side, at the same time cast off for armholes as the back and (82) 88 (90) 94 (100) 106 sts rem.

Cont until front meas (41) 43 (45) 47 (47) 48 cm from folding row.

Cast off the (29) 33 (33) 33 (33) 33 middle sts for neck, included cutting sts. Work each side separately.

Cast off at beg of every row at neck 2 sts 3 times, 1 st 4 times.

Cont until front meas (50) 52 (54) 56 (56) 57 cm. Transfer rem (19) 20 (21) 23 (26) 29 sts to spare ndl.

Work other side in the same manner but in a mirror image.

SLEEVES

With burnt tawny and 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (60) 60 (60) 60 (60) 60 sts.

Join and work stripe pattern in St-st for facing as follows:

Work 2 rnds St-st. Work 2 rnds burnt tawny, *2 rnds grey-beige melange, 2 rnds burnt tawny*, rep from *-* a total of 4 times.

Change to 3.5 mm double pointed ndls and p 1 rnd for folding rnd.

All further measurements from this rnd.

Work 2 rnds St-st. Change to grey-beige melange and work 2 rnds, change to burnt tawny and work 2 rnds, change to dk.blue and work 3 rnds.

Work diagram.

Change to dk.blue and cont until sleeve meas 25 cm.

Insert marker around first and last st of rnd.

Inc 1 st at each side of marker as follows: pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl this new st.

Rep inc every (5½) 4 (3) 2½ (2) 2 cm until (68) 70 (74) 76 (78) 80 sts.

Cont until sleeve meas 47 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off 8 middle underarm sts (= marked sts + 3 sts at each side).

Cont St-st back and forth and cast off at beg of every row at each side 3 sts (0)0(0)1(1)1

time, 2 sts (4)4(5)4(5)5 times, 1 st (13)13(13)13(12)12 times. Cont until sleeve cap meas (12) 13 (13) 14 (14) 15 cm.

Cast off at beg of every row at each side 1 st once, 2 sts once, 3 sts once. Cast off rem (6) 8 (8) 8 (8) 10 sts.

Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

FINISHING

Graft or knit shoulder sts tog.

With machine sew 2 seams at each side of middle front on cutting sts. Cut between seams.

Zigzag over cut edges.

TIPS: Work front bands and facing before cutting at middle front.

FRONT BAND

With dk.blue and 3 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row at left front edge (not on facing) to approx (90) 94 (98) 206 (106) 108 sts.
 From WS k 1 row, work 5 rows St-st, k 1 row from WS for folding row, work 5 rows St-st for facing.
 Cast off k tbl-wise (not too tight).
 Work other side in the same manner.


NECKBAND

With burnt tawny and 3 mm circular ndl knit up at neck edge approx 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row to approx (118) 122 (124) 124 (126) 128 sts.
 From WS k 1 row.
 Work 1 row St-st.
 Cont St-st and stripe pattern as follows:
 Work 2 rows grey-beige melange, 2 rows burnt tawny, rep from *-* once more.
 K 1 row from WS for folding row, 2 rows St-st, *work 2 rows grey-beige melange, 2 rows burnt tawny*, rep from *-* once more.
 Cast off k tbl-wise.
 Sew sleeves on.

TIE-BAND

With dk.blue and 3.5 mm circular ndl cast on 66 sts and k 1 row (first row = WS), 7 rows St-st, k 1 row from WS.
 Cast off.
 Work other tie-band in the same manner.
 With dk.blue and 3 mm crochet hook work crab sts on edges of tie-band.
 Fold all facings to WS and sew loosely.
 Sew one tie-band to left front, approx 16 cm from lower edge and 15 cm from front edge.
 Sew the other tie-band on right front approx 16 cm from lower edge and inside front band. (See photo).
