



#GRONLANDGENSER / NO 8 / INSTRUCTION: UNN SØILAND ***MEDIUM

SIZES

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (64) 69 (76) 80 (84) 89 cm Length: (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 53 cm

Sleeve length: (24) 28 (31) 35 (38) 42 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

THE GARMENT

Work back and front in rounds from hem up to underarms. Work sleeves to suitable length. Join sleeves to back/front and dec for round yoke. Work double neckband.

YARN

SISU (80 % wool, 20 % nylon, 50 g = 175 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, ALPAKKA SILKE, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT

NOTE: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn.

YARN REQUIRED

Moonstone #2122/Lt.green #9041: (2) 3 (3) 4 (4) 5 halls

Lt.moss green #9844/Dk.green #8063: (1) 1 (1) 2 (2) 2 balls

Blue hydrangea #6032/Dill #8552: 1 ball each size Old rose #4513/Blue hydrangea #6032: 1 ball each size

Rose tree #4245/Dk.blue #6062: 1 ball each size

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

GSR = GERMAN SHORT ROWS

After each turning always sl first st p-wise with yarn in front of work, lead yarn over right ndl and pull yarn firmly at the back until 2 loops on ndl. The 2 loops count as 1 st. When working rows/rnds with loops work loops to 1 st.

BACK AND FRONT

With lt moonstone/dk.green and 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (174) 186 (204) 216 (228) 240 sts. Join and work (4) 4 (5) 5 (6) 6 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl and work $\underline{\text{diagram A}}$. Insert marker at sides with (87) 93 (102) 108 (114) 120 sts for each part.

Change to moonstone/lt.green, and work St-st until garment meas (21) 24 (26) 30 (31) 33 cm.

Cast off 12 sts at each side for armholes (= 6 sts at each side of markers).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

SLEEVES

With lt.moss green/dk.green and 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (42) 44 (46) 48 (50) 52 sts. Join and work (4) 4 (5) 5 (6) 6 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls and work 1 rnd St-st while inc (6) 4 (8) 6 (10) 8 sts evenly spaced = (48) 48 (54) 54 (60) 60 sts.

Work $\underline{\text{diagram } A}$. Insert marker around first and last st on rnd = marked sts.

Change to moonstone/lt.green and cont St-st until sleeve meas (10) 10 (11) 11 (12) 12 cm. Inc 1 st on each side of marker as follows:

Knit 1, inc 1, work until 1 st rem, inc 1 and work last st. Rep inc every 2 cm until (60) 66 (72) 78 (84) 90 sts on ndl.

Cont until sleeve meas (24) 28 (31) 35 (38) 42 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off 12 middle underarm sts.

Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

YOKE

Transfer sleeve sts to the 3 mm circular garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (246) 270 (300) 324 (348) 372 sts.

Rnd beg by sts for the back.

Work (1) 1 (1) 1 (4) 6 rnds St-st with moonstone/ lt.green, at the same time adjust number of sts to (240) 260 (296) 324 (344) 372 on first rnd.

Insert marker at each junction and one marker at middle front.

Size (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Dec for raglan as follows: k2tog tbl before each marker, and k2tog after each marker = 8 sts dec. Rep dec on alt rnds (1) 2 (2) 3 times more.

All sizes:

= (240) 260 (280) 300 (320) 340 sts.

Work diagram B, C, D.

Note: See arrow in diagram and with blue hydrangea/ dill work turning rows with GSR to create and shape a deeper neckline on front as follows:

Knit until 15 sts rem before middle front marker, turn, purl until 15 sts rem before middle front marker on other side, turn.

Work and turn in the same manner, but turn 6,4,2 sts before previous turning, until a total of 4 times on each side.

When diagram is finished (108) 114 (120) 126 (132) 138 sts rem.

Knit 1 rnd with lt.moss green/dk.green, at the same time dec evenly spaced to (100) 104 (108) 112 (114) 116 sts.


NECKBAND

Change to 2.5 mm double pointed ndls, and work (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) 8 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Fold neckband double to WS and sew loosely with

Sew underarm openings, and fasten all yarn ends.
