STRIPED SWEATER

Striped raglan sweater Instruction: Liv Stangeland

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (65) 70 (74) 77 (83) 88

Length: approx (38) 42 (46) 50 (54) 54 cm

Sleeve length: (25) 29 (32) 35 (38) 40

cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

SMART (100 % wool, superwash, 50 g = 100 m)

Alternative yarn:

PEER GYNT, ALPAKKA, DUO, MANDARIN MEDI, MERINOULL

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Lt.grey melange #1032/Natural melange #2641: (2) 3 (4) 4 (5) 5 balls Terracotta melange #3846/Ochre #2527: (1) 1 (1) 2 (2) 2 balls

Old rose #4332/Olive green #9553: 1 ball all sizes

Ochre #2527/Sea green melange #7252: (1) 1 (1) 1 (2) 2 balls

Burnt terracotta #4036/Lt.sea green

#7721: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3.5 mm and 4 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

Tension:

20 sts St-st with 4 mm ndls = 10 cm

Stripe pattern:

*Terracotta melange/ Ochre: 10 rnds, Lt.grey melange/Natural melange: 10 rnds,

Old rose/Olive green: 10 rnds,

Lt.grey melange/Natural melange: 10 rnds,

Ochre/Sea green melange: 10 rnds, Lt.grey melange/Natural melange: 10 rnds.

Burnt terracotta/Lt.sea green: 10 rnds, Lt.grey melange/Natural melange: 10 rnds*, rep from *-*.

Sleeves:

With It.grey melange/natural melange and 3.5 mm circular ndl cast on (36) 38 (38) 40 (42) 44 sts. Join and work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 4 mm circular ndl, k 1 rnd while inc 4 sts evenly spaced = (40) 42 (42) 44 (46) 48 sts. Insert marker on first and last st on rnd. Cont St-st with stripe pattern, at the same time when sleeve meas (11) 11 (10) 10 (11) 10 cm inc 1 st at each side of marker.

Rep inc every (4) 4 (3½) 3½ (3) 3 cm until (46) 50 (54) 58 (62) 66 sts on rnd. Cont until sleeve meas (25) 29 (32) 35 (38) 40 cm, or suitable length. Cast off 6 middle underarm sts (= marked sts + 2 sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

Back and front:

With It.grey melange/natural melange and 3.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (142) 154 (162) 170 (182) 194 sts. Join and work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 4 mm double pointed ndls, k 1 rnd **while** dec (12) 14 (14) 16 (16) 18 sts evenly spaced = (130) 140 (148) 154 (166) 176 sts.

Insert marker at each side with (65) 70 (74) 77 (83) 88 for each part.

Meas sleeve to establish beg of srtipe pattern, to end with the same pattern rnd. Cont St-st and **stripe pattern** until garment meas approx (24) 26 (29) 32 (35) 33 cm.

Cast off 6 sts at each side for armholes (= 3 sts at each side of markers).

Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 4 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (198) 216 (232) 246 (266) 284 sts.

Insert marker at each junction.

Rnd beg at a junction on the back.

Cont **stripe pattern** and dec for raglan at each marker as follows:

K2tog before each marker, and sl 1, k1, psso after each marker.

Rep dec a total of (12) 13 (15) 16 (17) 19 times = (102) 112 (112) 118 (130) 132 sts.

Transfer the (11) 12 (14) 15 (15) 16 middle front sts to spare ndl for neck. Cut yarn and beg again at neck.

Cont back and forth and dec for raglan on RS rows

Cast off 2 sts at beg of every row further, at the same time cont raglan dec as before when possible (5) 5 (5) 5 (6) 6 times more, and a total of (17) 18 (20) 21 (23) 25 times over sts on the back.

Leave rem sts on ndl for neckband.

Finishina:

Sew underarm openings **Neckband**:

Transfer sts at neck to 3.5 mm circular ndl and with grey melange/natural melange knit up sts at neck edge. K 1 rnd **while** adjusting number of sts to approx (84) 86 (88) 90 (92) 94.

Work (3) 3 (3) 3½ (3½) 3½ cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Cast off rib-wise.





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
