Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

20 sts x 26 rnds St-st with 4 mm ndls = 10 x 10 cm

GERMAN SHORT ROWS

After each turning always sl 1 p-wise, lead yarn over right ndl, pull yarn firmly at the back until 2 loops on ndl.

The 2 loops count as 1 stitch.

When working rnds/rows with loops work loops tog to 1 stitch.

YOKE

With old rose/dk.blue and 3.5 mm circular ndl cast on (78) 80 (82) 84 (86) 88 sts. Join and work 6 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 4 mm circular ndl, k 1 rnd, while inc (12) 16 (26) 30 (34) 38 sts evenly spaced =

(90) 96 (108) 114 (120) 126 sts.

Insert marker at beg of rnd = middle back.

Cont St-st and work extra height at back with German Short Rows (see explanation) as follows:

Work until (28) 31 (36) 39 (41) 43 sts pass marker, turn, work until (28) 31 (36) 39 pass marker, turn and work until 3 sts pass previous turning until a total of 3 times at each side.

Work until marker at middle back.

Cont St-st and diagram and inc as shown in diagram = (162) 186 (204) 210 (234) 252 sts.

Divide for sleeves, back and front at arrow for chosen size as follows:

Work (26) 29 (30) 32 (35) 36 sts (= 1/2 back), transfer (30) 36 (42) 42 (48) 54 sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on 12 new underarm sts, work (51) 57 (60) 63 (69) 72 sts (= front), transfer (30) 36 (42) 42 (48) 54 sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on 12 new underarm sts, work (25) 28 (30) 31 (34) 36 sts (= 1/2 back).

SIZES

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (63) 69 (72) 75 (81) 84 cm

Length: (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm

Sleeve length: (24) 27 (30) 33 (36) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

YARN

SMART (100 % wool, Superwash, 50 g = 100 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN

PEER GYNT, ALPAKKA, DUO, MERINOULL

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

YARN REQUIRED

Old rose #4332/Dk.blue #6062: (4) 5 (6) 7

(8) 9 balls

Ochre #2527/Terracotta #3544: (1) 1 (2) 2 (2)


2 balls

Natural #1012/Natural melange #2641: 1 ball

all sizes

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed ndls 3.5 mm and 4 mm



BACK AND FRONT

= (126) 138 (144) 150 (162) 168 sts.

Cont St-st and [diagram](#) until garment meas approx (33) 37 (41) 45 (47) 49 cm, meas from shoulder straight down, or 3 cm before suitable length.

TIPS: Work a couple of rnds with old rose/dk.blue before ribbing.

Change to 3.5 mm circular ndl and work 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

SLEEVES

Transfer sts from spare ndl to 4 mm double pointed ndls, and knit up 1 st in each of the new underarm sts = (42) 48 (54) 54 (60) 66 sts.

TIPS: Pick up yarn between sleeve sts and the new sts at each side and k this new st tog with next st to avoid holes.

Insert marker at middle underarm.

Cont St-st and [diagram](#) and dec 1 st at each side of marker when sleeve meas approx 3 cm.

Rep dec approx every (4) 3 (2½) 2½ (2½) 2 cm until (32) 34 (36) 36 (38) 38 sts rem.

Cont until sleeve meas (21) 24 (27) 30 (33) 37 cm, or 3 cm before suitable length.

TIPS: Work a couple of rnds with old rose/dk.blue before ribbing.

Change to 3.5 mm double pointed ndls and work 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

FINISHING

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.
