



NO 2 SAILORMAN BUBBLE VEST

Vest w/bubble pattern Instruction: Olaug Beate Bjelland

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (59) 62 (68) 74 (80) 83 cm Length: approx (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

SISU (80 % wool, 20 % nylon, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, ALPAKKA SILKE, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT

NOTE: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn.

Yarn required:

Yellow sand #2134/ Dusty lt.green #9041: (2) 3 (4) 5 (5) 6 balls

Suggested kntting needles:

Circular 2.5 mm and 3 mm Double pointed 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

Tension:

27 sts and 48 rnds bubble pattern and 3 mm ndls = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$

Long stitch:

Insert right hand ndl through the 4th st below left hand ndl = under the p st. K this

NOTE: Make sure to unravel the 4 sts/ threads over each of the long stitches before continue knitting.

Bubble pattern worked in rounds:

Rnd 1: k all sts.

Rnd 2: Work *p1, k3*, rep from *-* in the

Rnd 3 - 5: k all sts.

Rnd 6: Work *1 long stitch, k3*, rep from *-* in the rnd.

Rnd 7: k all sts.

Rnd 8: Work k2, *p1, k3*, rep from *-*, end with p1 and k1.

Rnd 9 - 11: k all sts.

Rnd 12: Work k2, *1 long stitch, k3*, rep from *-*, end with 1 long stitch and k1. Rep rnd 1- 12.

Bubble pattern worked back and forth:

Row 1: (= WS) p all sts.

Row 2: Work *p1, k3*, rep from *-* in the rnd.

Row 3 - 5: Work St-st.

Row 6: Work *1 long stitch, k3*, rep from *-* in the rnd.

Rnd 7: p all sts.

Row 8: Work k2, *p1, k3*, rep from *-*, end with p1 and k1.

Row 9 - 11: Work St-st.

Row 12: Work k2, *1 long stitch, k3*, rep from*-*, end with 1 long stitch and k1. Rep row 1- 12.

Back and front:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (160) 168 (184) 200 (216) 224 sts. Join and work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Change to 3 mm circular ndl. Insert marker around 1 st at each side with (79) 83 (91) 99 (107) 111 sts between marked sts. Beg with marked st at side and work **bubble pattern** in rnds until garment meas approx (24) 27 (30) 33 (34) 35 cm, end with 6th or 12th pattern rnd, **at the same time** cast off 7 sts at each side for armholes (= marked st + 3 sts at each side).

Work each side separately.

Edge st: k every row

Back:

= (73) 77 (85) 93 (101) 105 sts.

(63) 71 (71) 75 sts rem.

Beg from WS with 1st or 7th pattern row, and p all sts back.

Cont **bubble pattern back and forth**, and ensure to match bubbles further in work. **At the same time** cast off for armholes at beg of every row at each side, 3 sts once for all sizes, 2 sts (1)1(1)1(2)2 times, 1 st (6)6(6)6(8)8 times = (11) 11 (11) 11 (15) 15 sts cast off at each side and (51) 55

Work **bubble pattern** inside 1 edge st at each side until garment meas approx (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm, end with 1st or 7th pattern row.

Transfer sts to spare ndl = (10) 11 (14) 16 (16) 17 shoulder sts at each side and (31)

33 (35) 39 (39) 41 middle sts for neck.

Front:

= (73) 77 (85) 93 (101) 105 sts. Work and cast off for armholes as the back.

Cont **bubble pattern** inside 1 edge st at each side until garment meas (29) 33 (37) 41 (42) 44 cm.

Cast off the (15) 17 (19) 21 (21) 21 middle sts for neck and work each side separately. Cont cast off at neck 3 sts once all sizes, 2 sts (1)1(1)1(1)2 times, 1 st (3)3(3)4(4)3 times. Cont until garment meas approx (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm and end with the same pattern row as the back. Transfer rem (10) 11 (14) 16 (16) 17 shoulder sts to spare ndl.

Work other side in the same manner.

Finishing:

Knit or graft shoulder sts tog.

Neckband:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up approx (96) 104 (112) 116 (120) 124 sts at neck edge.

Number of sts a multiple of 2. Work approx 2 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Armhole bands:

With 2.5 mm double pointed ndls knit up approx 1 st every st/row, but miss approx every 3rd st/row at armhole edge until approx (94) 100 (104) 110 (120) 126 sts on rnd.

Number of sts a multiple of 2. Work approx 1,5 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Cast off rib-wise.

Work the other side in the same manner.
