ORNAMENTS

Felted ornaments w/embroidery

Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Size:

Approx 7 cm across

Yarn:

TOVE (100 % Norwegian wool, 50 g = 160 m)

MANDARIN HEKLEGARN (crochet yarn) (100 % mercerized cotton, 100 g = 590 m)

Yarn required:

TOVE

Natural #1012: 2 balls

MANDARIN HEKLEGARN

Red #4228: 2 balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular 4 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

Tension:

22 sts St-st with 4 mm ndls = 10 cm

With circular ndl cast on 100 sts. Join and work St-st in rnds until yarn from both balls are finished, only leaving enough yarn for casting off. Cast off.

Felting:

Felt work in washing machine at 40C with regular detergent (do not use special detergent for white) on a regular cycle.

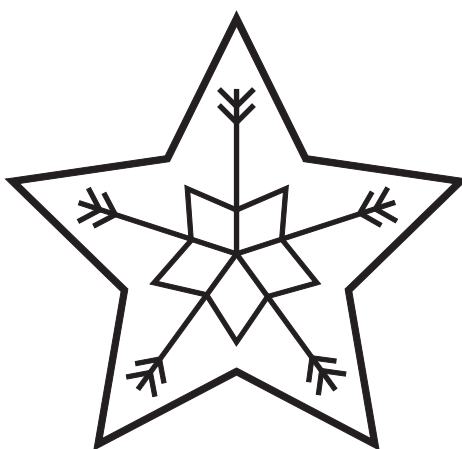
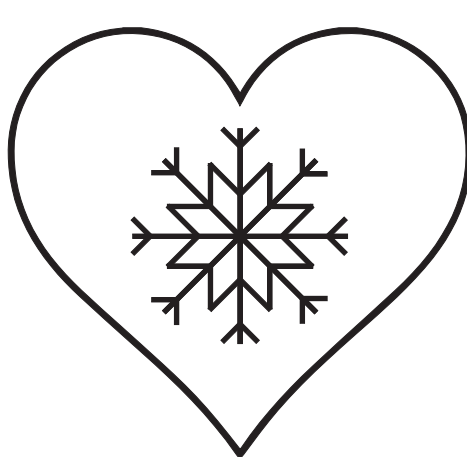
Ensure work to be felted enough to avoid ravel when cutting the fabric.

Finishing:

Cut 2 pieces of each shape.

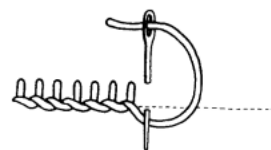
With back stitches and crochet yarn (Mandarin Heklegarn) embroider at both sides.

With blanket sts sew 2 shapes tog at edges and make loop for hanging at top. See photo.



Back stitch:

Sew from top down to make a continous line. From WS bring ndl through fabric up to RS, insert ndl above yarn end for length of stitch and bring ndl up again for the same stitch length below yarn end. Cont in this manner and always insert ndl exactly where previous stitch ended.



Blanket stitch.

Insert ndl straight down through fabric with yarn under ndl and pull through.
