HAT W/CABLES

Hat for children Instruction: Liv Stangeland

Sizes:

(2-4) 6-8 (10-12) yrs

Yarn:

TYNN ALPAKKA ULL (65 % alpaca, 35 % wool, 50 g = 166 m)

Yarn required:

Emerald #7755: (1) 1 (2) balls

Alternative yarn:

TOVE

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular 2.5 mm and circular and double pointed 3 mm

Cable ndl

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

30 sts pattern with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

With 2.5 mm circ ndl cast on (100) 106 (110) sts. Join and work (6) 7 (9) cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 3 mm circ ndl, p 1 rnd, while inc (0) 4 (10) sts evenly spaced = (100) 110 (120) sts. Work diagram, and after first rnd = (120) 132 (144) sts on ndl.

Cont until work meas (16-18) 20 (22) cm, end with a full pattern repeat. Dec as shown in diagram = (40) 44 (48) sts


Work (k2tog) in the rnd = (20) 22 (24) sts

Cut yarn, pull through sts, gather and fasten well.

Finishing:

Make a small pompom, diameter approx (3) 4 (4) cm and fasten at top of hat.

Fold ribbing to RS.



k on RS, p on WS

p on RS, k on WS

transfer 2 sts to cable ndl in back of work, k2, k sts on cable ndl

transfer 2 sts to cable ndl in front of work, k2, k sts on cable ndl

transfer 2 sts to cable ndl in front of work, p2, k sts on cable ndl

transfer 2 sts to cable ndl in back of work, k2, p sts on cable ndl

pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl this new st

k2tog

p2tog
