## BILLIE BONNET

Bonnet w/ knit and purl pattern Instruction: Anita Brathetland

#### Sizes:

(0-3) 6 (9) mos 1 (2) yrs

#### Yarn:

BABYULL LANETT (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

#### Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, TYNN MERINOULL, ALPAKKA SILKE, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

#### Yarn required:

Putty #1015/Dusty pastel green #8521/Dk.grey melange #1053: (1) 1 (2) 2 (2) balls

#### Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

#### Tension:

27 sts diagram with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

#### Begin at face edge.

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (80) 88 (92) 100 (104) sts, and work 2 cm ribbing back and forth in this manner: (First row = WS) 1 edge st, p2, \*k2, p2\*, rep from \*-\* end with 1 edge st. Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

Work **diagram** back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side until work meas approx (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) cm, end with a full diagram.

Join and work 1 rnd diagram.

Dec on next rnd as follows:

\*K2, k2tog\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd = (60) 66 (69) 75 (78) sts.

Work 7 rnds diagram.

Work \*k1, k2tog\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd = (40) 44 (46) 50 (52) sts.

Work 7 rnds diagram.

Work k2tog in the rnd = (20) 22 (23) 25 (26) sts.

Work 1 rnd St-st with no dec.

Work k2tog in the rnd, end with k(0) 0 (1) 1 (0) = (10) 11 (12) 13 (13) sts.

Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well.

#### Neckband:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up approx (72) 76 (80) 84 (88) sts at neck edge and work 4 cm ribbing back and forth as at beg of work.

Number of sts a multiple of 4.

Cast off rib-wise.

Fold band to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.

#### Cord:


With 2.5 mm double pointed ndl cast on 4 sts and work in this manner: k 1 row, slide sts back to other end of ndl, hold yarn firmly and k sts. Rep this and always k sts from same side without turning.

Cont until cord meas approx (70) 72 (74) 76 (78) cm.

Cast off.

Pull cord through neckband.

# BILLIE JUMPSUIT

Jumpsuit worked from neck down in knit and purl pattern.

Instruction: Anita Brathetland

#### Sizes:

(0-3) 6-9 mos (1) 2 (4) yrs

#### **Measurements:**

Chest width: approx (50) 56 (61) 65 (69) cm

Length: approx (55) 66 (72) 79 (92)

Leg length: (18) 26 (30) 34 (42) cm + 4 cm foldover, or suitable length Sleeve length: (14) 18 (22) 26 (29) cm + 3 cm foldover, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

#### Yarn:

BABYULL LANETT (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

#### Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, TYNN MERINOULL, ALPAKKA SILKE, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

#### Yarn required:

Dk.grey melange #1053: (5) 6 (7) 8 (9) balls

#### Notions:

(7) 7 (7) 8 (8) buttons

### Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

#### Tension:

27 sts diagram with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

#### Inc 1 st:

Pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl this new st

Edge st: k every row

#### Beg at neck:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (68) 72 (76) 80 (84) sts and work 2 cm ribbing back and forth in this manner: (First row = WS) 1 edge st, p2, \*k2, p2\*, rep from \*-\* end with 1 edge st. Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

Work 2 rows **diagram** inside 1 edge st at each side.

Cont **diagram** and inc as follows on next row: Work \*2 sts, inc 1 st\*, rep from \*-\* end with 4 sts = (100) 106 (112) 118 (124) sts.

Work 11 rows diagram.

Inc as follows: Work \*3 sts, inc 1 st\*, rep from \*-\* end with 4 sts = (132) 140 (148) 156 (164) sts.

Work 11 rows diagram.

Inc as follows: Work \*4 sts, inc 1 st\*, rep from \*-\* end with 4 sts = (164) 174 (184) 194 (204) sts.

Work 11 rows diagram.

Inc as follows: Work \*5 sts, inc 1 st\*, rep from \*-\* end with 4 sts = (196) 208 (220) 232 (244) sts.

Work 11 rows diagram.

Inc (0) 12 (20) 24 (32) sts evenly spaced = (196) 220 (240) 256 (276) sts

Cont **diagram** until work meas (11) 12 (13) 14 (15) cm.

Divide work in this manner:

Work (29) 33 (36) 39 (42) sts (= front), transfer (40) 44 (48) 50 (54) sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on 8 new underarm sts, work (58) 66 (72) 78 (84) sts (= back), transfer (40) 44 (48) 50 (54) sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on 8 new underarm sts, work (29) 33 (36) 39 (42) sts (= front).

#### **Back and front:**

= (132) 148 (160) 172 (184) sts.

Insert marker around 2 sts at each side with (32) 36 (39) 42 (45) sts for each front, and (64) 72 (78) 84 (90) sts for the back.

All further measurements from this row.

Cont **diagram** back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side until work meas 2 cm.

Inc 1 st at each side of markers = (136) 152 (164) 176 (188) sts.

Rep inc when work meas 4 cm = (140) 156 (168) 180 (192) sts.

Cont until work meas approx (24) 26 (27) 29 (33) cm.

Work 2 rows diagram, at the same time cast on 3 new sts at end of every row = (146) 162 (174) 186 (198) sts. Join work and cont 10 rnds diagram in rnds.

Cast off 12 sts at middle front and middle back, and work each leg separately.

#### Leg:

= (61) 69 (75) 81 (87) sts.

Cont **diagram** in rnds. Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls when necessary.

Insert marker at beg of rnd.

When leg meas 2 cm dec 1 st at each side of marker.

**NOTE:** Dec on rnd with k sts and k2tog after marker, k2tog tbl before marker.

Rep dec approx every (1½) 2 (2) 2 (2½) cm until (45) 49 (53) 53 (59) sts rem.

Cont until leg meas (14) 22 (26) 30 (38) cm, or approx 4 cm before suitable length.

Change to 2.5 mm double pointed ndls and work 8 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds, at the same time adjust number of sts to (44) 48 (52) 52 (56) on first rnd.

Cast off rib-wise.

Fold ribbing to RS.

Work other leg in the same manner.

#### Sleeves:

Beg at middle of the 8 underarm sts, and with 3 mm double pointed ndls knit up 4 sts, work sleeve sts in **diagram** and knit up 4 sts = (48) 52 (56) 58 (62) sts on rnd.

Insert marker at beg of rnd.

Cont **diagram** in rnds and when sleeve meas 2 cm dec 1 st at each side of marker.

**NOTE:** Dec in the same manner as for leg.

Rep dec approx every  $(2\frac{1}{2})$  2 (3) 3  $(3\frac{1}{2})$  cm until (40) 40 (44) 44 (48) sts rem.

Cont until sleeve meas (11) 15 (19) 23 (26) cm, or approx 3 cm before suitable length.

Change to 2.5 mm double pointed ndls and work 6 cm ribbing k2, p2, Cast off rib-wise.

Fold ribbing to RS.

Work other sleeve in the same manner.

#### Finishing:

#### Left front band girl/ right boy:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up approx (96) 104 (108) 116 (124) sts at front edge

Number of sts a multiple of 4.

Work 2 cm ribbing back and forth as at neck.



Cast off rib-wise.

Right front band girl/ left boy:


Work in the same manner as other side but work (7) 7 (7) 8 (8) buttonholes evenly spaced after 1 cm. The upper and lower approx 2 cm from ends of band.

Buttonhole: k/p2tog, 1 yo.

Cast off rib-wise

Place buttonhole band over button band and sew at bottom of slit.

Sew buttons on.

## BILLIE CARDIGAN

Cardigan worked from neck down w/knit and purl pattern.

Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(0-3) 6-9 mos (1) 2 (4) yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (50) 56 (61) 65 (69) cm Length: approx (24) 26-29 (31) 36 (40) cm

Sleeve length: (14) 18 (22) 26 (29) cm or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

BABYULL LANETT (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, TYNN MERINOULL, ALPAKKA SILKE, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Putty #1015: (3) 3 (4) 5 (6) balls

**Notions:** 

(5) 5 (6) 6 (6) buttons

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts diagram with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Inc 1 st:

Pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl this new st

Edge st: k every row

Begin at neck:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (68) 72 (76) 80 (84) sts and work 2 cm

ribbing back and forth in this manner: (First row = WS) 1 edge st, p2, \*k2, p2\*, rep from \*-\*, end with 1 edge st Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

Work 2 rows **diagram** inside 1 edge st at each side.

Cont **diagram** and inc as follows on next row:

Work \*2 sts, inc 1 st\*, rep from \*-\*, end with 4 sts = (100) 106 (112) 118 (124) sts.

Work 11 rows diagram.

Inc as follows: Work \*3 sts, inc 1 st\*, rep from \*-\* end with 4 sts = (132) 140 (148) 156 (164) sts.

Work 11 rows diagram.

Inc as follows: Work \*4 sts, inc 1 st\*, rep from \*-\* end with 4 sts = (164) 174 (184) 194 (204) sts.

Work 11 rows diagram.

Inc as follows: Work \*5 sts, inc 1 st\*, rep from \*-\* end with 4 sts = (196) 208 (220) 232 (244) sts.

Work 11 rows diagram.

Inc (0) 12 (20) 24 (32) sts evenly spaced = (196) 220 (240) 256 (276) sts.

Cont **diagram** until work meas approx (11) 12 (13) 14 (15) cm.

Divide work as follows:

Work (29) 33 (36) 39 (42) sts (= front), transfer (40) 44 (48) 50 (54) sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on 8 new underarm sts, work (58) 66 (72) 78 (84) sts (= back), transfer (40) 44 (48) 50 (54) sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on 8 new underarm sts, work (29) 33 (36) 39 (42) sts (= front).

Back and front:

= (132) 148 (160) 172 (184) sts.

Insert marker around 2 sts at each side with (32) 36 (39) 42 (45) sts for each front, and (64) 72 (78) 84 (90) sts for the back.

All further measurements from this row.

Cont **diagram** back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side until work meas 2 cm.

Inc 1 st at each side of markers = (136) 152 (164) 176 (188) sts.

Rep inc when work meas 4 cm = (140) 156 (168) 180 (192) sts.

Cont **diagram** until work meas approx (24) 26-29 (31) 36 (40) cm from highest point of shoulder straight down with garment placed flat.

End with a full **diagram** and cast off k-wise from RS.

Sleeves:

With 3 mm double pointed ndls beg at middle of the 8 new underarm sts. Knit up 4 sts, work sleeve sts in **diagram** and knit up 4 sts = (48) 52 (56) 58 (62) sts in rnd.

Insert marker at beg of rnd.

Cont **diagram** in rnds and when sleeve meas 2 cm dec 1 st at each side of marker.

**NOTE:** Dec on rows with k sts and k2tog after marker, k2tog tbl before marker.

Rep dec approx every  $(2\frac{1}{2})$  2 (3) 3  $(3\frac{1}{2})$  cm until (40) 40 (44) 44 (48) sts rem.

Cont until sleeve meas (11) 15 (19) 23 (26) cm, or approx 3 cm before suitable length.

Change to 2.5 mm double pointed ndls and work 3 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds

Cast off rib-wise.

Work other sleeve in the same manner.

Finishing:

Left front band girl/ right boy:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up approx (64) 68-72 (80) 88 (96) sts at front edge

Number of sts a multiple of 4. Work 2 cm ribbing as at neck.

Cast off rib-wise.


Right front band girl/ left boy:

Work in the same manner as other side but with (5) 5 (6) 6 (6) buttonholes evenly spaced after 1 cm. The upper and lower approx 2 cm from ends of band.

Buttonhole: k/p2tog, 1 yo.

Cast off rib-wise

Place buttonhole band over button band and sew at bottom of slit. Sew buttons on.
