STRIPED CARDIGAN

Cardigan w/stripe pattern Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(0-3) 6 (9) 12 mos (2) 4 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (48) 52 (56) 60 (64) 68 cm

Length: approx (24) 26 (28) 31 (36) 40 cm

Sleeve length: (13) 15 (18) 21 (23) 26 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

TYNN MERINOULL (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, ALPAKKA SILKE, MANDARIN PETIT, BABYULL LANETT, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Dusty pastel green #8521: (2) 2 (2) 3 (3) 3 balls White #1002: (1) 1 (1) 1 (2) 2 balls Petrol #6562: 1 ball all sizes

Notions:

(5) 5 (5) 6 (6) 6 buttons

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with pattern and 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Edge st: k every row

Back and front:

With dusty pastel green and 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (125) 135 (145) 157 (167) 179 sts, and work (2) 2 (2)

2 (3) 3 cm ribbing back and forth in this manner:

(First row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-* end with 1 edge st. Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

Cast on 5 new sts at end of row for cutting sts. These sts are not included in given number of sts or pattern.

Insert marker around 1 st at each side with (30) 32 (34) 38 (40) 42 sts for front and (63) 69 (75) 79 (85) 93 sts for the back.

Join and cont St-st and **diagram** in rnds until garment meas approx (15) 15 (17) 18 (22) 24 cm.

End with a full stripe and cast off 7 sts at each side for armholes (= marked st + 3 sts at each side).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:

With dusty pastel green and 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (34) 36 (38) 40 (42) 44 sts. Join and work (2) 2 (2) 2 (3) 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls, and insert marker around first st of rnd.

Beg **diagram** and meas length for sleeve on back/front to start with the right stripe. When sleeve meas 4 cm inc 1 st at each side of marker.


Cont **diagram** and rep inc approx every (2) 1½ (2) 2 (1½) 1½ cm until (42) 48 (50) 56 (62) 68 sts.

Work new sts in diagram as they arise.

Cont until sleeve meas approx (13) 15 (18) 21 (23) 26 cm.

End with the same rnd as back/front, and cast off 7 middle underarm sts (= marked st + 3 sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve the same



Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (181) 203 (217) 241 (263) 287 sts.

Work 1 rnd **diagram**, k2tog at each junction and insert marker around each of these 4 sts = (177) 199 (213) 237 (259) 283 sts and 4 markers.

Cont **diagram** and dec for raglan at each marker as follows:

Work until 1 st before marker, sl 2

k-wise (as working k2tog), k1, psso = 8 sts dec.

Rep inc on alt rnds (9) 11 (13) 14 (16) 18 times = (105) 111 (109) 125 (131) 139 sts.

Cast off the (13) 13 (13) 15 (15) 15 middle front sts for neck, included cutting sts.

Cont **diagram** back and forth and cast off for neck at beg of every row at each side 3 sts once for all sizes, 2 sts twice for all sizes, 1 st (2)2(2)3(3)3 times, **at the same time** cont raglan dec when possible (5) 5 (5) 6 (6) 6 times more, and a total of (14) 16 (18) 20 (22) 24 times of dec over sts for the back.

NOTE: Dec for raglan on RS rows. Leave rem sts on ndl for neckband.

Finishing:

With machine sew 2 seams at each side of middle front on cutting sts, and cut between.

Zigzag over cut edges.

TIPS: Work front bands and facing before cutting.

Left front band girl/ right front band boy:

With dusty pastel green and 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up at front edge 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row to approx (57) 63 (69) 77 (87) 97 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work 2 cm ribbing back and forth as for back/front.

Cast off rib-wise.

Right front band girl/ left front band boy:

Work in the same manner as other side but work (5) 5 (5) 6 (6) 6 buttonholes evenly spaced after 1 cm. The lower approx 2 cm from cast on, the upper on neckband. This is done later.

Buttonhole: k2tog, 1 yo Facing:

With dusty pastel green and 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up from WS 1 st in each st on first row of front band. Work 5 rows St-st back and forth.



Cast off. Fold facing over cut edge and sew nicely with hidden sts. Work the same on other side **Neckband:** Transfer neck sts to 2.5 mm circular ndl and with dusty pastel green knit up sts at neck to approx (73) 77 (81) 85 (89) 93 sts. Number of sts a multiple of 2+1. Work 2 cm ribbing back and forth as for back/front. Remember last buttonhole after 1 cm Cast off rib-wise.

Sew buttons on.

Sew tog at underarms.

STRIPED ROMPER

Romper w/stripe pattern Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(0-3) 6-9 mos (1) 2 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (50) 55 (61) 65 cm Length: approx (32) 36 (38) 43 cm All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

TYNN MERINOULL (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, ALPAKKA SILKE, MANDARIN PETIT, BABYULL LANETT, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Dusty pastel green #8521: (1) 1 (1) 2 balls White #1002: 1 ball all sizes Petrol #6562: 1 ball all sizes

Notions:

4 snaps 2 buttons

Suggested knitting needles

Circular 2.5 and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with pattern and 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

INFO: There will be quite a few yarn ends to fasten, but for this cute result it is worth the effort.

TIPS: To avoid cutting yarn after each row with «dots», work last row and first row for each new stripe from the same side. This is only possible when working back and forth and without inc or dec.

Edge st: k every row Back:

With white and 3 mm circular ndl cast on (21) 21 (23) 23 sts, and p 1 row from WS.

Work (14) 14 (20) 20 rows **diagram** back and forth, inside 1 edge st at each side.

Work meas approx (4) 4 (6) 6 cm.

Cont **diagram**, **at the same time** cast on 3 new sts at end of each row at each side (8) 9 (10) 11 times = (69) 75 (83) 89 sts.

Transfer sts to spare ndl and work front.

Front:

With (dusty pastel green) dusty pastel green (white) white and 3 mm circular ndl cast on (21) 21 (23) 23 sts, and p 1 row from WS.


Cont **diagram** and beg at arrow for chosen size, **at the same time** cast on at end of every row at each side 6 sts (0)0(once)once, 5 sts twice for all sizes, 4 sts twice for all sizes, 3 sts (2)3(2)3 times = (69) 75 (83) 89 sts. **NOTE:** End with the same row as at

NOIE: End with the same row as at back.

Back and front:

Transfer all sts to the same 3 mm circular ndl = (138) 150 (166) 178 sts. Work 1 rnd **diagram**, k2tog at each junction and insert marker around this st = (136) 148 (164) 176 sts, and 2 markers.

Cont **diagram** in rnds until romper meas approx (20) 22 (24) 27 cm at middle front.



End with a full stripe, at the same time cast off (9) 9 (11) 11 sts at each side for armholes (= marked st + (4) 4 (5) 5 sts at each side). Work each side separately.

Back:

= (59) 65 (71) 77 sts.

Cont **diagram** inside 1 edge st at each side, and cast off at beg of every row at each side 3 sts (3)4(5)5 times, 2 sts (2)1(1)2 times, 1 st once for sizes 6-9-mos **only** = (33) 35 (37) 39 sts.

Cont **diagram** until back meas approx (6) 7 (7) 8 cm from dividing for armholes, end with a full stripe. Leave sts on ndl and work front.

Front:

= (59) 65 (71) 77 sts.

Cont **diagram** inside 1 edge st at each side, and cast off in the same manner as the back = (33) 35 (37) 39 sts.

Cont **diagram** until front meas approx (5) 6 (6) 7 cm from dividing for armholes, end with a full stripe. Leave sts on ndl.

Finishing:

Armhole bands:

With dusty pastel green and 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up at armhole edge approx 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row to approx. (49) 57 (65) 73 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work 1 cm ribbing back and forth as follows: (First row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-* end with 1 edge st.

Cast off rib-wise.

Work in the same manner at other armhole

Buttonhole band on front:

With dusty pastel green and 2.5 mm circular ndl pick up and work 4 sts over armhole band, work front sts and pick up and work 4 sts over the other armhole band to = (41) 43 (45) 47 sts. Work 2 cm ribbing as armhole bands, at the same time work 1 buttonhole at each side as follows after 1 cm:

Work 4 sts, k2tog, 1yo, work until 6 sts rem, 1 yo, k2tog, work 4 sts. Cast off rib-wise.

Band and straps on the back:

With dusty pastel green and 2.5 mm circular ndl pick up and work 4 sts over armhole band, work front sts and pick up and work 4 sts over the other armhole band to = (41) 43 (45) 47 sts.



Work 2 cm ribbing as armhole bands. Cast off the (27) 29 (31) 33 middle sts, and work each strap separately. Cont ribbing until strap meas approx (9) 10 (11) 12 cm, or suitable length. Work other strap in the same manner.

Leg band:

With dusty pastel green and 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up approx (59) 63 (67) 71 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work 2 cm ribbing back and forth as follows: 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st.

Cast off rib-wise.

Work the other leg band in the same manner.

Button band:

With dusty pastel green and 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st in each st/row at cast on row and over leg bands at back to approx (33) 33 (35) 35 sts. Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work 2 cm ribbing as leg for band. Cast off rib-wise.

Work button band at front in the same manner Sew snaps on at crotch

Sew buttons on straps.



No 18C STRIPED HAT

Hat with stripe pattern Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(0-3) 6-9 mos (1) 2 (4) yrs

Yarn:

TYNN MERINOULL (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, ALPAKKA SILKE, MANDARIN PETIT, BABYULL LANETT, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Dusty pastel green #8521: 1 ball all sizes White #1002: 1 ball all sizes Petrol #6562: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3 mm Circular 2.5 mm Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with pattern and 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

With dusty pastel green and 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (96) 100 (104) 108 (112) sts. Join and work (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl

Work **diagram** until hat meas approx (13) 14 (15) 16 (17) cm, end with a full stripe.

Distribute sts equally on 2 ndls, hold parts with RS facing and k 1 st from each ndl tog, **at the same time** cast off

Earflaps:

With dusty pastel green and 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (40) 40 (44) 44 (48) sts. Join and work (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) cm St-st in rnds.

Insert marker at sides with (20) 20 (22) 22 (24) sts for each part.

Dec on next rnd: sl 1, k1, psso after each marker, and k2tog before each marker. Rep dec on alt rnds until 4 sts rem. Cont to work cord over the 4 sts as follows:

K 1 row, slide sts back to other end of ndl, hold yarn firmly and k sts. Rep this and always k sts from same side without turning

Cont until cord meas approx (20) 20 (22) 24 (26) cm.


Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well.

Work other earflap in the same manner.

Finishing:

Sew earflaps to inside of ribbing of hat at row between ribbing and St-st, and with approx (6) 7 (7) 8 (8) cm between earflaps at middle back.

In dusty pastel green make 2 pompoms with Ø approx $3\frac{1}{2}$ cm and fasten one to each corner at top

STRIPED BONNET

Bonnet with stripe pattern Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(0-3) 6-9 mos (1) 2 yrs

Yarn:

TYNN MERINOULL (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, ALPAKKA SILKE, MANDARIN PETIT, BABYULL LANETT, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Dusty pastel green #8521: 1 ball all sizes White #1002: 1 ball all sizes Petrol #6562: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3 mm Circular 2.5 mm Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

TIPS: To avoid cutting yarn after each row with «dots», work last row and first row from same side for each new stripe.

Edge st: k every row

Begin at face.

With dusty pastel green and 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (73) 81 (89) 97 sts, and work 2 cm ribbing back and forth as follows: (First row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-* end with 1 edge st.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

Work 1 row **diagram** inside 1 edge st at each side and inc 8 sts evenly spaced = (81) 89 (97) 105 sts.

Cont **diagram** back and forth until work meas approx (12) 13 (14) 15 cm, end with a full stripe.

Join work, cont in rnds with double pointed ndls, and on first rnd k tog first and last st of rnd = (80) 88 (96) 104 sts.

Insert marker around this st and around every 8th st in the rnd = (10) 11 (12) 13 markers.

Cont **diagram** in rnds and dec at each marker as follows:

Work until 1 st before marker, sl 2

k-wise (as working k2tog), k1, psso = (20) 22 (24) 26 sts dec.

Rep dec every 4th rnd until (20) 22 (24) 26 sts rem.

Work 1 rnd diagram.

K2tog in the rnd = (10) 11 (12) 13 sts. Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well.

Neckband:

With dusty pastel green and 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up approx (65) 73 (81) 89 sts at neck edge and work 4 cm ribbing back and forth as at beg of bonnet.

Cast off rib-wise.

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.

Cord:


With dusty pastel green and 3 mm double pointed ndl cast on 4 sts and work as follows:

K 1 row, slide sts back to other end of ndl, hold yarn firmly and k sts. Rep this and always k sts from same side without turning

Cont until cord meas approx (64) 66 (68) 70 cm.

Cast off.

Pass cord through neck band.





No 18E STRIPED KNEE SOCKS

Knee socks w/stripe pattern Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(0-3) 6 (9) 12 mos (2) 4 yrs

Measurements:

Foot length: (10) 10½ (11) 12 (13) 15 cm

Sock length: (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) 16 cm + heel

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

TYNN MERINOULL (100 % merinoull, 50 gram = ca 175 meter)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, ALPAKKA SILKE, MANDARIN PETIT, BABYULL LANETT, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Dusty pastel green #8521: 1 ball all sizes

White #1002: 1 ball all sizes Petrol #6562: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Double pointed 3 mm Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with pattern and 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Edge st: k every row

With dusty pastel green and 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (42) 46 (50) 54 (58) 58 sts. Join and work 2 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Insert marker around first st on rnd. Cont **diagram** until work meas approx (3) 4 (5) 6 (7) 9 cm. Dec as follows at marker: Work until 1 st before marker, sl 2 k-wise (as working k2tog), k1, psso = 2 sts dec.

The rem st from dec is the new marked st.

Cont **diagram** and rep dec approx every 1 cm until (30) 34 (38) 42 (46) 46 sts rem.

Cont **diagram** until work meas approx (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) 16 cm, end with a full stripe.

Insert marker around the (15) 17 (19) 21 (23) 23 instep sts and with dusty pastel green work heel over rem (15) 17 (19) 21 (23) 23 sts at back as follows:

Work $(2\frac{1}{2}) 2\frac{1}{2} (3) 3 (3\frac{1}{2}) 4$ cm St-st back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side.

Next row: Work until (4) 5 (6) 6 (7) 7 sts rem at one side, turn and work until (4) 5 (6) 6 (7) 7 sts rem at other side.

Turn and work until 1 st before turning, sl 1, k1, psso, turn and work until 1 st before turning at other side, p2tog.

Turn and dec in this manner at each side until all side sts are dec

Pick up (8) 9 (10) 10 (11) 11 sts at each side of heel

Insert marker at each side of instep sts.

Cont **diagram** in rnds over all sts, **at the same time** dec 1 st at each side of instep sts as follows: k2tog before marker, and k2tog tbl after marker.

Rep dec on alt rnds (3) 5 (5) 5 (5) 5 times = (32) 32 (36) 40 (44) 44 sts on rnd.

Cont **diagram** over all sts until foot, including heel sts, meas (8) $8\frac{1}{2}$ (9) 10 (11) 13 cm, or until approx 2 cm before suitable length, end with a full stripe.

Cont with dusty pastel green and dec for toe as follows: k^2 , k^2 tog^{*}, rep from *-* in the rnd = (24) 24 (27) 30 (33) 33 sts.


Work 2 rnds with no dec.

Next rnd: *k1, k2tog*, rep from *-* in the rnd = (16) 16 (18) 20 (22) 22 sts Work 2 rnds with no dec.

Next rnd: k2tog in the rnd = (8) 8 (9) 10 (11) 11 sts rem.

Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well.

Work other sock in the same manner.
