STRIPED SWEATER

Raglan sweater w/stripes
Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (64) 68 (73) 76 (80) 86 cm

Length: approx (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm

Sleeve length: (24) 27 (30) 33 (36) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

TYNN MERINOULL (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, ALPAKKA SILKE, MANDARIN PETIT, BABYULL LANETT, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

White #1002: (2) 2 (2) 2 (3) 3 balls

Dk.curry #2336: (1) 1 (2) 2 (2) 2 balls

Rust #3345: 1 ball all sizes

Dusty pastel green #8521: 1 ball all sizes

Petrol #6562: 1 ball all sizes

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Sleeves:

With dk.curry and 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (42) 44 (46) 48 (50) 52 sts. Join and work 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls. Insert marker around first st on rnd.

Work **diagram** and when sleeve meas 4 cm inc 1 st at each side of marked st.

Cont **diagram** and rep inc approx every 2 cm until (62) 64 (70) 76 (82) 84 sts on ndl.

Work new sts in diagram as they appear.

Cont until sleeve meas (24) 27 (30) 33 (36) 40 cm, or suitable length, end with a full stripe.

Cast off 7 middle underarm sts (= marked st + 3 sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

Back and front:

With dk.curry and 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (172) 184 (196) 204 (216) 232 sts. Join and work 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

Insert marker at each side with (85) 91 (97) 101 (107) 115 sts between sts.

Work **diagram** until garment meas approx (22) 26 (28) 31 (31) 32 cm, meas on sleeve to establish beginning of diagram to end with the same rnd as sleeve. Cast off 7 sts at each side for armhole (= marked st + 3 sts at each side).

Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (268) 284 (308) 328 (352) 372 sts.

Rnd beg at a junction on the back.

Work 1 rnd **diagram**, k2tog at each junction and insert marker around each of these 4 sts = (264) 280 (304) 324 (348) 368 sts, and 4 markers.

NOTE: Ensure pattern to match further.

Cont **diagram** and dec for raglan at each marker in this manner:

Work until 1 st before marker, sl 2 k-wise (as working k2tog), k1, pssso.

Rep dec on alt rnds (12) 14 (16) 17 (20) 22 times = (168) 168 (176) 188 (188) 192 sts.

Transfer the (13) 13 (15) 15 (17) 19 middle front sts for neck to spare ndl.

TIPS: If necessary work one more raglan dec for ending with a full stripe before transfer of neck sts to spare ndl. This is for the nicest finish.

Cut yarn and beg again at neck.

Cont **diagram** back and forth and cast off at beg of every row at each side, 3 sts once for all sizes, 2 sts (2)3(3)2(1)2 times, 1 st (5)4(4)6(7)6

times, **at the same time** cont raglan dec (8) 8 (8) 9 (9) 9 times more to a total of (20) 22 (24) 26 (29) 31 times of dec over sts for the back.

NOTE: Work raglan dec on RS-rows. Leave rem sts on ndl for neckband.

Finishing:

Sew underarm openings

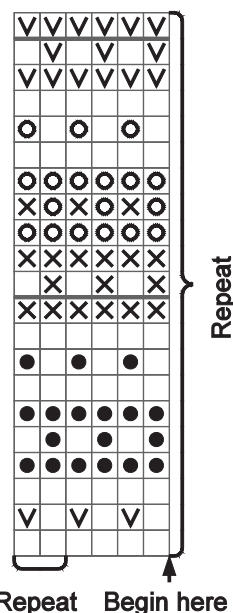
Neckband:

With dk.curry and 2.5 mm circular ndl knit sts from spare ndl, and knit up sts at neck edge.

Work 1 rnd St-st, **at the same time** adjust number of sts to (104) 108 (112) 116 (120) 124.

Work 8 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.
