# SEAMAN SWEATER

Sweater w/structural pattern Instruction: Åsa Christiansen

#### Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

#### Measurements:

Chest width: (66) 71 (74) 77 (83) 86

Length: approx (36) 40 (44) 48 (52) 54 cm

Sleeve length: (26) 30 (33) 36 (39) 42 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

#### Yarn:

KOS (62 % baby alpaca, 9 % wool, 29 % nylon, 50 g = 150 meter) TYNN MERINOULL (100% merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

### Yarn required:

KOS

Grey melange #1043/Beige #3532: (3) 4 (4) 5 (6) 7 balls TYNN MERINOULL Grey-blue #6071/Rust #3345: (2) 3 (3)

4 (5) 5 balls

#### Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 7 mm Small circular 6 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

#### Tension:

14 sts pattern with double yarn (1 strand KOS + 1 strand TYNN MERINO ULL) and 7 mm ndls = 10 cm

Work garment with double yarn, 1 strand KOS + 1 strand TYNN MERINO ULL

#### **Back and front:**

With double yarn and 7 mm circular ndl cast on (92) 100 (104) 108 (116) 120 sts.

Insert marker around 1 st at each side with (45) 49 (51) 53 (57) 59 sts between markers.

Work **diagram** in rnds until garment meas approx (24) 27 (30) 33 (36) 37 cm.

Cast off 7 sts at each side for armholes (= marked st + 3 sts at each side).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

#### Sleeves:

With double yarn and 7 mm double pointed ndls cast on (32) 34 (36) 38 (40) 42 sts. Insert marker around first st

Join and work **diagram** in rnds until sleeve meas approx (26) 30 (33) 36 (39) 42 cm, or suitable length. End with the same pattern rnd as back/front.

Cast off 7 middle underarm sts (= marked st + 3 sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

#### Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 7 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off, and **at the same time** k2tog at each junction (= insert marker around these 4 sts and k each of the 4 sts further) = (124) 136 (144) 152 (164) 172 sts on rnd.

Adjust pattern and work 2 rnds diagram.

Dec for raglan on alt rnds as follows: k2tog after each marked st, and k2tog tbl before each marked st = 8 sts dec. Rep raglan dec (7) 8 (9) 10 (11) 12 times = (68) 72 (72) 72 (76) 76 sts. Transfer the (7) 9 (9) 9 (11) 11 middle front sts for neck to spare ndl Cont to end of rnd, cut yarn and beg again at neck.

Work pattern back and forth and cont dec for raglan, at the same time cast off at beg of every row at neck on each side 2 sts once, 1 st twice until a total of (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) 15 raglan dec where this is possible


Leave sts on ndl for neckband.

#### Finishing:

With double yarn and small 6 mm circular ndl knit sts on ndl and knit up sts at neck edge to approx (40) 44 (48) 52 (56) 60 sts.

Work approx 2 cm St-st in rnds. Cast off suitably tight.

Sew underarm openings.
