SNOWBELL COLLAR

Worked from hem up
Instruction: Olaug Beate Bjelland

Sizes:

(2-4) 6-8 (10-12) yrs

Measurements:

Length: ca 12 cm, all sizes

Neck width: approx (31) 35 (39) cm

All measurements are for the finished garment
= personal body measurements + movement
allowance. The measurements are all according
to given tension.

Yarn:

MERINOULL (100 % merino wool,
50 g = 105 m)

Alternative yarn:

PEER GYNT, SMART, ALPAKKA,
DUO

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to
check the yardage on label. The image of
garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Sand-shell #2125: 2 balls all sizes

Notions:

1 button

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular 3 mm, 3.5 mm and 4 mm

Crochet hook 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your
knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker
needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

22 sts pattern with 3.5 mm ndls
= 10 cm

Edge st: k every row

Beg at hem.

With 4 mm circular ndl cast on (117)
131 (145) sts, and k 3 rows back and
forth = 2 ridges (first row = WS).

Change to 3.5 mm circular ndl

Work **diagram** inside 2 edge sts at
each side and dec as shown in
diagram = (69) 77 (85) sts.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl, cast on
3 new sts at beg of row and work

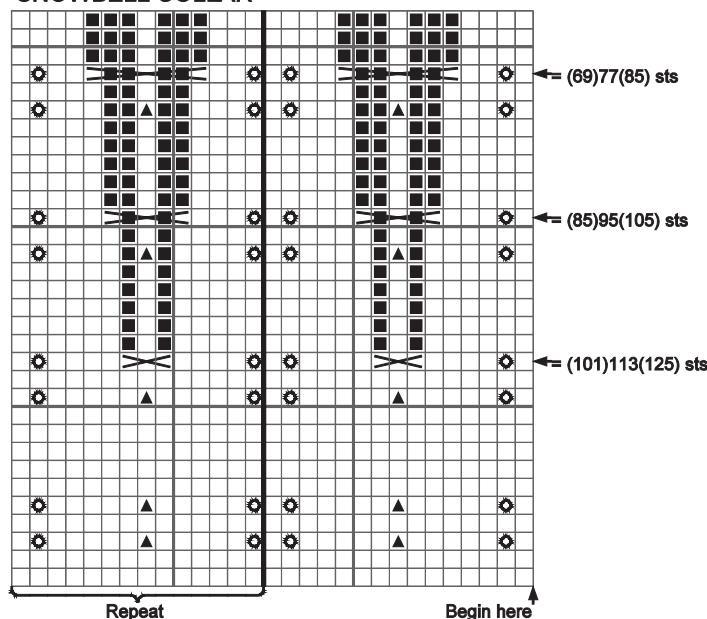
i-cord edging as follows: k2 and k2 tbl
tog, *transfer 3 sts back to left ndl, k2,

sl 1 k-wise, k1, psso*, rep from *-*
until 3 sts rem, k2tog and k1. Transfer
2 sts to left ndl and k2tog = the last 2
sts .

Transfer st to 3 mm crochet hook, ch3
for button loop, and fasten loop with 1
sl in the last st at edge.

Sew button on.

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□ k on RS, p on WS

⊗ 1 yo

▲ sl 1 k-wise, k2tog, psso

⊗ sl 2 k-wise, k3tog, psso

■ No stitch, skip
